

**PRIVACY NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA
VOICE RECORDING**

A. Data Controller

In accordance with the [Personal Data Protection Law No. 6698](#) (“**Law**”), we would like to inform you that as Data Controller, Deutsche Bank A.Ş. (“**Bank**”) will process your personal data within the scope explained in this notice.

B. Your Processed Personal Data, the Purposes of Processing Your Personal Data, and Legal Grounds

Article 5 of the Law regulates the legal grounds for processing personal data. Below, we have provided the purposes for which we process your personal data, as well as the corresponding legal grounds on which such processing activities are based.

C. Methods of Collecting Your Personal Data

Your personal data is collected through the collection of information/documents via information systems, by automatic and partially automatic means.

D. Third Parties with Whom Your Personal Data is Shared and Purposes of Sharing

Your personal data is transferred to third parties in accordance with the Law for the purposes set out below:

Your personal data is transferred abroad in compliance with the Regulation on the Procedures and Principles Regarding the Transfer of Personal Data Abroad, published in the Official Gazette dated July 10, 2024 and numbered 32598, and other relevant legislation, by ensuring appropriate safeguards. Necessary technical and administrative measures are taken to ensure that cross-border data transfer is carried out securely.

E. Your Rights Regarding Your Personal Data

With respect to your personal data, you may submit your requests within the scope of Article 11 of the Personal Data Protection Law at any time in writing or by using a registered electronic mail (KEP) address, secure electronic signature, mobile signature, or the electronic mail address you have previously provided to Deutsche Bank and which is registered in our system, in accordance with the “Communiqué on the Principles and Procedures of Application to the Data Controller.”

If you submit your requests regarding your rights to the Bank through the Data Subject Application Form available at <https://country.db.com/turkey/kisisel-verilerin-korunmas> the Bank will finalize your application free of charge as soon as possible and at the latest within thirty days, depending on the nature of your request. However, if the process requires an additional cost, the Bank may charge a fee according to the tariff determined by the Personal Data Protection Board.
